

Bunny



Skill Level: Beginner

You'll love this beginner project! So cute and just in time for Easter! It is created from 1 square of stockinette stitch and folded into this little bunny. All you need to know is how to cast on, knit, purl and bind off.

Supplies: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ 50 yards White Glow Uptown Worsted yarn (1 skein = 180 yards/165 m)○ Scrap yarn in black, grey and pink○ Size 8 straight needles, or size to obtain gauge○ Yarn needle for sewing○ Stuffing	Gauge: 5 sts x 6 rows = 1"
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With white yarn, cast on 30 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until piece measures 6 inches and shaped like a square (36 rows).

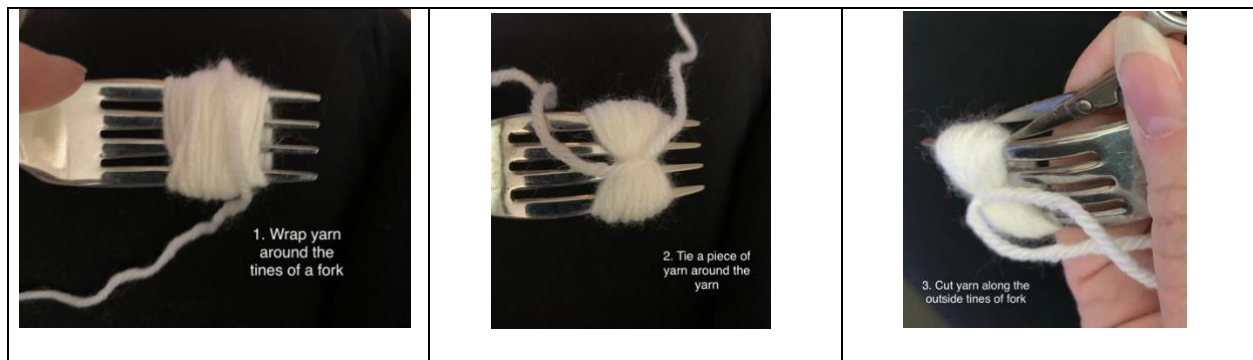
Bind off.

Stitch a triangle using white yarn and yarn needle in the top half of the square. Start the row of sewing across the middle. After the triangle is done, pull on both yarn ends and the head will form.



Stuff the head and body and sew the back and bottom closed.

Give your bunny a face by embroidering eyes, nose, mouth and whiskers. Attach a small pom pom for it's tail. (A fork can be used to make a small pom pom.)
